1st Day of School (Gr. 1st -6th) August 6, 2018

- Homeroom lists will be posted in the elementary (1-5) and middle school (Grade 6) cafeterias.
- Students in Grade 1st-5th will report to their homeroom class by 7:55 am. Parents can stay with their students during first period. All parents must leave the rooms by the time bell rings.
- 6th grade students will go to the cafeteria directly and their parents will not be allowed to go inside. 6th grade teachers should report to the cafeteria at 7:55 am to pick up their kids and walk with them to the classroom.
- 6th grade students will find their homeroom from the lists posted on the cafeteria wall and line up with their homeroom teacher in the cafeteria at 8:00 am and will be picked up by their teachers as well.
- **Teachers without a homeroom class will help monitor students as they go to their homeroom class.**
- **All students will remain in their homeroom (DEAR) for the first period.**
- During this time teachers will:
 - -Pass out student schedules.
 - If a student has a blank schedule, please contact Mrs. Del Curto.
 - Students who didn't take STAR Math/Reading for Art or Foreign Language, they must go to Computer lab.
 - -Go over the bell schedule and a map with teacher room numbers.
 - -Explain the warning bell and passing period.
 - -Release students to find their lockers and put up backpacks, cell phones and purses during their scheduled time.
 - 6th grade Students who didn't get lockers must visit room Science Lab, room 207.
- Students will report to their second period class after the bell rings at 8:47am. **During second period students will have time to organize their lockers. Top Lockers (ODD Numbers); 8:55- 9:15 Bottom Lockers (EVEN Numbers): 9:15- 9:35**
