



### Textbook Policy

Textbooks are purchased through funds provided by the New Mexico Public Education Department Instructional Materials budget and are the property of the State of New Mexico. Albuquerque School of Excellence will hold each student's parent/guardian responsible for the condition of the textbooks issued to student. Each student must take care to see that textbooks are not lost, stolen, damaged, or defaced. Students will have to pay to replace any books that are damaged or not returned. Failure to pay for the damaged or stolen textbooks may result in withholding the report card or transcripts. (Section 22-15-10.B NMSA 1978)

In compliance with SB 1019 Albuquerque School of Excellence will provide core courses with enough textbooks so that students have a copy of the book to take home when necessary.

This Textbook Policy is adopted by the Governing Council of Albuquerque School of Excellence, effective as of 10/12/2013.
